Consider This...For those Who Would Be Fathers

We have been told for many years of the extremely high volume of phone calls to mothers on Mothers' Day. Maybe you have wondered how that number compares to calls to fathers on Fathers' Day. AT&T produced their study on this question.

Phone calls to fathers are growing at a faster rate than phone calls to mothers. The number of phone calls to mothers is still much larger, but the gap is narrowing. There is one stark difference between the phone calls on these two days. Fathers' Day phone calls far outpace Mothers' Day phone calls for collect calls made!

In a report on June 2012, Snopes.com verified this information from AT&T. Because of the proliferation of cell phones and pre-paid calling cards, there is no way to judge how long this trend will continue. But, one thing we know; there is a difference between the perceptions of mothers and fathers.

Traditionally, we have turned to our mothers for emotional support and we have turned to our fathers for financial support and advice. We are much more likely to ask dad for money and advice than we are to ask mom.

So, what advice can a father give those who, one day, will be fathers? Determine, before you begin your journey as a father, to work hard at keeping the lines of communication open between you and your children. Paul's admonition to fathers concerning their children in Ephesians 6:4 is, "...bring them up in the training and admonition of the Lord."

They may, when they are on their own, call mom more often and they may call you in some way that allows you to pay for it. But, they will always want your advice and words. I remember well how my own dad felt when his dad died. He said, "We spoke every Saturday night. That will be hard to do without."

The day will come when your father will be gone and you will miss him. Take advantage now of the opportunities you have to spend time with him in person or over the phone. You will miss that one day. Meanwhile, make sure your children will miss you!

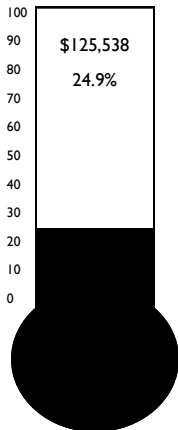
