Your Faith Is Spoken Of (Romans 1-4) by Tim Dooley

What a wonderful acclamation of Paul to the Christians in Rome that their faith was spoken of throughout the whole world (1:8). How wonderful it would be if the faith of every Christian today was spoken of the same way. Consider a few things Paul says in the opening chapters of this letter because, even though we all sin and fall short of His glory (3:23), there are a few things we must do in order for our faith to be commended.

Be not ashamed of the gospel of Christ (1:16)
 Live by faith (1:17).

Glorify Him and be thankful for what he has done for you (1:21).

Be patient and steadfast in seeking eternal glory, honor, and immortality (2:7).

Do good in order to ensure His blessings (2:10).

Be doers of the law of Christ and love in order to be justified (2:13).

The faithful, however, do not do these things so that their faith may be spoken of by men. We do all we can to hear our faith spoken of by Christ in Judgment. "Well done, good and faithful servant; you were faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things. Enter into the joy of your lord" (Matthew 25:21). [Tim]

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Guess what? Last Friday, my son Hailey and I went fishing at Maleme dam in Matopos National Park. We spent the whole day fishing. I tell you my brother, it was so refreshing! This is my hobby! Hailey caught more fish than me! Hoping he will be a better fisher of men than me. I have not been to fishing for a long time and we really enjoyed this fishing trip.

On Saturday, I led a Bible discussion on Christian Marriage for married couples at Bulawayo Central Church of Christ. Guess what? More than 30 married couples attended. I was very happy indeed and we gave the Lord all praise! We shared ideas on how to apply Christian principles in our homes. Our theme came from James 1:22.

Then on Sunday morning, I preached at the funeral of the late sister Gladys Sutter -73 at Horton Farm in Tsholotsho. After the funeral, we went to worship with our brothers and sisters at Stanhope. It was a very busy weekend indeed.

On Monday, I took our Gospel Beaver (the truck) for checking at a GM garage because of strange sounds emanating from the front wheels especially when driving on rural roads. They discovered that the front suspension needs immediate attention. They gave me a list of things which need replacement:

1. Upper wishbone bushes
2. Ball joints
3. Brake calipers & holders
4. Tire rod ends
5. Brake linings

Brother Craig, I will get quotations and then see what needs fixing first. Our rural roads are death traps because they are in a very poor state. I am sure you know these roads because you have been here before. We need to fix the truck because we are using it to take food to the needy in rural congregations and we also use it for Gospel meetings and carrying people for baptism and sometimes carry the dead for burial in rural areas. This is why we call it our "Gospel Beaver".
