My emphasis for lecturers who worked at Mutare School of Preaching between 1971-1979 was that : they were godly men who were focussed, committed and resilient in sustaining the Lord's work during difficult political times. At the close of the workshop, the school authorities handed me 20 Papyrus Solar Audio Players with all the curriculum for the Sunset International Bible Institute which is in Lubbock, Texas. They suggested that we can use this information in teaching our students further Bible knowledge. Am happy that the brethren

in this country do realize the pivotal role which the WBS in Bulawayo plays in teaching the Bible to all people.

Then this afternoon I preached at the funeral of Charles Matore - 35 who passed on after a short illness.

In the morning, I preached at Njube on Matthew 3:8. We then distributed food to eight widows. I failed to do this last time because I got so busy preparing for the Mutare trip.
