He Sees Everything *by Tim Dooley*

From false balances and just weights to pride and humility Proverbs 11-15 reminds us of the vast dichotomy between the righteous and the wicked. In a world that seems to ever blur the lines between good and evil, sees little difference between right and wrong, and often sees the right as wrong and the wrong as right, we need to be reminded that God doesn't...and He sees everything!

Far too often we fail to see clearly the steps we take, the path we walk, or the very nature of our own hearts. Certainly the "way of the fool is right in his own eyes" and he doesn't see himself as a fool. But God sees the fool for what he truly is. The soul-winner is wise, but few pursue this way. The one guilty of contention is he who is arrogant and many

have fallen victim to this great evil. The man who loves his child punishes the son's misbehavior, but "love" has caused many parents to forsake discipline and society is plunged deeper into heartache because of it. A soft answer is better than an angry reply, but have you driven in traffic lately?

These general truths however are often scoffed at and unappreciated. "There is a way which seems right unto a man, but the ends thereof are the ways of death." The eyes of the Lord are everywhere, beholding the true righteousness and wickedness of man (Proverbs 15:3). It is therefore imperative that we see things through God's eyes and not our own. Be faithful, for the Lord is "far from the wicked: but he hears the prayer of the righteous" (Proverbs 15:29). [Tim]

## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Today I handed brother William Munengi \$350.00. This money will be used to buy mealie meal for 70 needy families at Manjolo and Msenampongo Churches of Christ in Binga. Brother William preaches at Manjolo. He will be assisted by brother Laimon Siachakupa the preacher at Msenampongo to buy mealie meal at Binga Center. Brother William had brought his son Chilo for medical check up at Mpilo. Giving these brethren money so that they may buy food at their local business Center is much cheaper for us because driving to Binga to and fro is more than 1000 kms thus we shall Save much on fuel and accommodation. They will use a donkey drawn cart to carry the mealie meal to their villages. Brother William thanked all

our brothers and sisters who sacrificed to feed the hungry in Binga. Lord willing we shall send \$100 via eco cash to brother Mnkuli in Binga tomorrow so that he too can buy food for the needy at Kariangwe. \$100 will feed 20 families. This congregation is almost 430kms north of Bulawayo. Binga is one of the driest provinces which received very little rainfall last year.

I also handed Jacob Moyo \$300 which was donated by Concord Church of Christ for food relief.
