Wisdom Can Be Worldly *by Mike Johnson*

Wisdom is an interesting concept to me. I have known people who had no real “formal” education who are some of the wisest and knowledgeable people I have ever known! Their formal education consisted of a few years, maybe through elementary school and into middle or high school, but certainly not a high school diploma and college was out of the question!

Their learning came from life. Admittedly, most of them grew up on a farm and worked all their lives. They learned from what they had to do to keep their families fed, housed, and clothed. And, the lessons they learned were powerful and true.

There is another wisdom that people learn. It is a wisdom that parades itself as wise but is, in reality, foolish. Paul discusses this wisdom in the first chapter of Romans. It is a wisdom that continues to bring the wrath of God into the world (Romans 1:18).

God’s wrath continues to be poured out on those who choose to be guided by this worldly wisdom. Paul teaches, in Romans 1, that the Gentiles are guilty before God “because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts and their foolish hearts were darkened Professing to be wise, they became fools...” (Romans 1:20-21) Homosexual conduct grew out of this worldly wisdom. This is but one example of how worldly wisdom destroys Biblical faith.

Solomon was the wisest man who ever lived but he did some of the most foolish things. The book recounts his missteps and failures. It also reports Solomon’s attitude that grew out of his experiences. “Vanity of vanities,” says the Preacher; “Vanity of vanities, all is vanity.” (Ecclesiastes 1:2) Though his wisdom had come from God, he did not use it properly. He let the world around him define his wisdom.

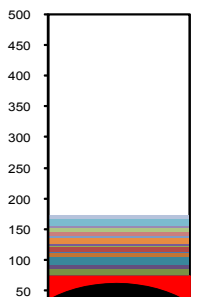
