A Lively Hope by Tim Dooley

In 1 Peter 1 we read that God has, "according to His abundant mercy... begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you" (vs. 2-3). "Begotten us again" comes from a single Greek word that means "to cause to be born again." This new life is a life of living hope that we have through the resurrection of Jesus following His death on the cross.

The eternal result of this new life of hope is an inheritance that is...

Death-proof: Incorruptible here means immortal or

imperishable. The inheritance will never cease to be. It is eternal!

Dirt-proof: Undefiled! It has never been, nor will it ever be soiled, deformed, or debased. Its force and potency never impaired.

Decay-proof: It never fades away. Its beauty is perennial!

This inheritance is reserved in heaven for all those who have arisen to live in hope of it. Have you been obedient to the gospel of Christ? Are you faithfully living in earnest anticipation of the inheritance reserved in heaven? Obey Him today and be faithful. Heaven will surely be worth it all! [Tim]

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Greetings from Zimbabwe!

We trust and hope that you will enjoy the summary reports of the Lord's work in June 2017. Let us begin by sharing with you a very sad story but with a huge moral lesson on forgiveness. "A family will never get over losing their loved ones. It doesn't matter how long ago or how old the loved one was or how they died. The family lives with this pain every moment of their remaining lives." Narin Grewal. With this in mind, during our visit to South Africa for medical check up in April this year, we came across a story written by a Sowetan journalist. He wrote: "One of Rhodes Park widows

has forgiven the men who attacked and killed her husband in 2015. "I forgave them because if I don't forgive, God will equally punish me for my sins. Though it was a very difficult decision to make, I had to pray for God to give me strength to forgive them". Siphokazi Tyeke and Jabu Mbatha were raped by Mthimkhulu Ndlovu- 23, Thabo Nkala -25 and Mduduzi Mathibela -32. Their husbands Zukisa Kela and Sizwe Tyeke were killed during a robbery at Rhodes Park, Kensington, Johannesburg after they were forced to jump into the lake where they drowned." Sowetan Newspaper. Surely as Christians, do we have any reasons why we should not forgive our brother or sister?
