"What shall we say then? Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God Forbid. How shall we, that are dead to sin, live any longer therein? Know ye not that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death; that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life." Romans 6:1-4

You Are In Control! *by Tim Dooley*

"The devil made me do it!" "I can't help it!" Statements like these are all to frequent from the mouths of those who have obey the gospel of Christ and made Jesus their Lord and Savior. In Romans chapter six Paul makes it clear that each one of us is in control of our own spiritual lives.

You choose either to yield yourselves as servants of righteousness or the slaves of unrighteousness. The Spirit tells us to "not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts. And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God" (vs. 12-13). In verse 16 He says "to whom you present yourselves slaves to obey, you are that one's slaves whom you obey,

whether of sin *leading* to death, or of obedience *leading* to righteousness?"

What we learn from this clear and simple text is that we are in control! I fear that to many Christians are guilty of granting Satan more power and control over them than he really has. We need to take control of our lives and let the word of God and the spirit of Christ lead us. Nobody makes me mad, I choose to be mad. No one makes me miserable, I choose to be miserable. No one makes me loose my hope of heaven, I give it up!

Remember, "You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world" (1 John 4:4). Take control of your life today by allowing Christ to reign in your heart. Take control of your destiny and your eternity by submitting yourself unto Christ and not unto sin! [Tim]
