Spiritual Genealogy by Tim Dooley

I have always been interested in history and especially family history. My project the only year I was in 4-H as a boy was on genealogy. For years I have wanted to trace my families history and this past week I finally took the opportunity to go back to Eastern Kentucky to research my father's side of the family.

I found what I expected to find...not much. My grandfather moved to Ohio in 1957 and in 1967 and 1969 sold the entire family farm that he had acquired from my great-grandfather. Since then the farm is grown over, someone has built a cabin (the old ones are long gone). The family burial plots on the farm have long since been lost. The descriptions on the deeds to the property are not much help. The descriptions include rocks, houses (that no longer exist), the lost family cemeteries, a hickory tree, and a garden that hasn't been tilled or planted for many years. There are few folks left that even remember the Dooley name and only two discernible grave sites are there; my great-grandfather and grandmother and one of his sons and his wife.

Beyond my great grandfather's grave there is no memorial to the previous three generations that died in Lawrence County. I did find the obituary of my great great-grandfather, marriage licenses, and death certificates in addition to the land deeds.

This week drove home a few spiritual applications as well. One, time passes swiftly and we are soon forgotten. The Psalmist said he was "forgotten as a dead man out of mind" (Psalm 31:12). As of right now I have no evident information beyond my 5th great-grandfather. There are many ancestors who are unknown to all future generations. Some future generation may soon have no memory or memorial of me. I hope though that I can leave a spiritual legacy for years to come.

Two, the only thing that really matters in life is if we live in such a way as to hear the Father say, "Well done, *thou* good and faithful servant: thou hast been faithful over a few things, I will make thee ruler over many things: enter thou into the joy of thy lord" (Matthew 25:21). "For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul" (Matthew 16:26). "Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep his commandments: for this *is* the whole *duty* of man" (Ecclesiastes 12:13).

Three, Christ is coming again and all that are in the grave shall hear is voice and shall come forth from their resting places; some to the resurrection of life and others to the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29). While many lie in unmarked, lost graves God won't need a marker when He comes to take us home.

Four, I am thankful for the family I have. For the ancestors who loved me enough to teach me the truth and lived lives that exemplified Christ. I am also thankful for wide reaching spiritual family. For their love, support, friendship, and encouragement.

Lastly, I am thankful for my Point Pleasant family! We missed you and you were in our thoughts and prayers while we were away. We are glad to be back and eager to be busy about our Father's business.

I will be making more trips in the future and continue my search to learn as much as I can about my family heritage. But my prayer is that the heritage I leave for my family will be one of love, obedience, and faithfulness to the Father of our souls. "Thy name, O LORD, *endureth* for ever; and thy memorial, O LORD, throughout all generations" (Psalm 135:13).

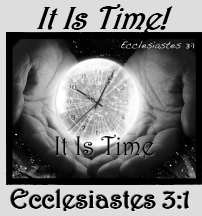
