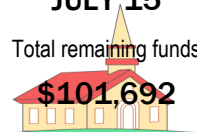
BUILDING FUND

Blessed In Christ *by Jason T Carter*

Have you ever read something in the Scriptures that made you scratch your head? Jesus says in His famed sermon on the mount, "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted" (Matthew 5:4). How often have you felt "blessed" while mourning? Isn't this a paradox?

Throughout the Scriptures, we see what we would consider negative events lead to positive results. Consider the inspired words of Romans 5:3-4 (tribulation à perseverance à hope), Hebrews 12:11 (chastening à peaceable fruit of righteousness), 2 Corinthians 7:10 (godly sorrow à repentance leading to salvation), and James 1:2-3 (trials/testing of faith à patience). In each instance, we start with something negative, but the end result is something positive.

The mourning under consideration in Matthew 5 does not refer to everyday sorrows, as Paul tells us that "the sorrow of the world produces death" (2

Corinthians 7:10). J.W. McGarvey writes in his commentary on Matthew and Mark that this is "those who mourn in reference to sin. 'They shall be comforted' because now there is an ample provision made for pardon."

"But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. And not only *that*, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation." (Romans 5:8-11)

We no longer have to mourn over our hopelessness, but "rejoice" that "through (Christ) we have now received the reconciliation." Truly we are blessed!

JUNE 2018 Monthly Report, Part 1

Brother Craig,

Greetings in the mighty name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We hope that this summary report of the Lord's work in Zimbabwe for June 2018 will find you well and busy in His vineyard.

Baptism

We are happy to inform you that during the month in review six souls were baptized and added into the Lord's body. Two ladies and a man were baptized in Bulawayo by brother Siphon and two ladies and a young man were baptized at Red bank by brother Nyathi.

Please pray for us

We earnestly need your prayers. Zimbabweans will

go to the polls on 30 July 2018. This is promising to be an election void of hate speeches, harassment or violence. However, on 23 June 2018, violence once again raised its ugly head when two men allegedly tried to assassinate the incumbent president Emerson Mnangagwa. A hand grenade was thrown at him after a political rally at the White City Stadium here in Bulawayo and it exploded just a short distance from him. It claimed two lives and injured many people who are very close to the president. Fortunately, in his response, President Mnangagwa never retaliated nor was he vindictive. Instead he urged all citizens of Zimbabwe to be calm and peaceful. He reiterated his wish that this year's presidential and parliamentary elections should be conducted very peacefully, all citizens being free in exercising their right to vote without intimidation. This is our wish too, for we cannot preach freely when

there is political turmoil in the country. We earnestly plead for your prayers. II Thess 3:1.

Food distribution

During the month in review, we did not do much in distributing food relief to the needy because our truck broke down completely. However, the Elders at Rainbow Church of Christ came to our rescue. They sent us enough funds which enabled us to fix the truck. We are now back at work and started by ferrying the body of the late brother Mpfu for burial at Chesa Forest. We shall begin distributing food again this coming weekend. We say to the Rainbow leadership, thank you so much for your financial assistance and may God bless you as you continue laboring for His glory.
