What's In A Name? *by Jason T Carter*

First John 3:23 tells us, "And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment."

Juliet pondered, "What's in a name? That which we call a rose by any other name would smell as sweet." While that may be true in the young lover's mind as she considered Romeo, nothing could be further from the truth when it comes to our Lord Jesus. The name of Christ is of utmost importance to the Christian, and the Scriptures explain why.

Near the conclusion of his account of the gospel, John explains, "And truly Jesus did many other things in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book; but these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you

may have life in His name" (John 20:30-31). John says that God gives life to believers in the name of Jesus.

Peter takes it even further, stating that it is *exclusively* in the name of Jesus. He says, "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12). This statement excludes Mohammed, John Smith, the Pope, and any other religious leader.

The apostle Paul wrote, "Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father" (Philippians 2:9-11).
