Elder's Update

Building Fund

It's been said more than once, and it's obvious when you attend Point Pleasant, that we are a growing family. As we continue to grow, we need a new building. We will also need to renovate the existing building to flow and work with the new facility. We have challenged the Point Pleasant family in our giving, and we have seen you rise to that challenge. We are impressed and so thankful for your response to the contribution increases. However, now is not the time to lose momentum. We have listened to your suggestions regarding what more can be done, and we are responding. **On the 3rd Sunday night of every month**, one of the men of the congregation will be bringing us the evening sermon. The Lord's Supper will be provided for those unable to partake at the morning service, as will the opportunity to give. However, the collection trays will be passed to everyone, not just the few. This will be for those that did not have an opportunity in the morning service to worship in giving, but also it will be a special opportunity for everyone to give specifically for the building fund. All the work we are involved in currently must continue, so what you give for the building fund is to be in excess over and above your normal giving; it is not meant to replace it. If you can not give financially above what you already are, we understand that. However we know and have been asked to provide a dedicated time so those who can give extra and more to the building fund can do so. Our hope is that if you will find a little extra to contribute once a month, and rally behind this special extra effort, then we can begin building quicker.

Benevolence

"So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to everyone, and especially to those who are of the household of faith." Gal. 6:10. We need to come together when our family needs it. We can't do everything but we can do something. Over the last year we have had more request for benevolence within the family than we've ever had before. As your shepherds, we are not going to prioritize a building fund while at the same time turn away from our family when an emergency arises. We believe that God will provide what we need; when we need it. We just need to trust Him more. **On the 4th Sunday night of July**, we will provide a special giving opportunity for the congregation to help cover the funeral expenses of our sister Amy Turner. There was no insurance, but the expenses have been paid in full. This special collection will help to cover those expenses. Please be praying about what you are able to give.

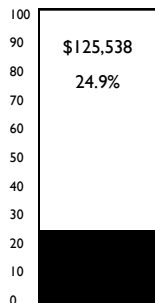
