## THE SONG OF SOLOMON *by Tim Dooley*

The Song of Solomon is first and foremost a song which expresses love between a man and a woman. It walks us through their courtship, marriage, and relationship. Many have sought to define the song as describing the love of God for Israel or the love of Christ for the church. While we can make application toward these things from the song neither are its original context.

From the context of the song we can make application to most any relationship. When it comes to those we love do we care about their vulnerability (physically, emotionally, and spiritually)? Do we care about their purity? For any relationship to be successful there must be a mutual appreciation, a mutual affection, and a mutual accountability. The success of any personal relationships is something for which we must be personally responsible! When we place the responsibility on the other party we fail to take

ownership and will be ultimately at fault for its failure.

Secondly, divorce is a rampant plague on our families and our society that is born out of selfishness and ungodliness. It may not be popular, but it is biblical, to recognize that the wife is the property of the husband and the husband is the property of the wife! But so much more than just property a spouse is a precious treasure to be cared for, protected, and loved. Solomon's bride acknowledges that "I and my beloved's, and my beloved is mine" (6:3), and "I am my beloved's, and his desire is toward me" (7:10). Spiritually speaking as Christians we must acknowledge that we are not our own but have been bought (1 Corinthians 6:19). Submission to our spouses will protect and save our marriages and families. 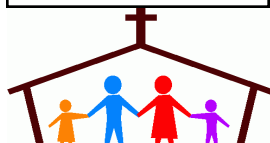

### **JUNE 2019 MONTHLY REPORT : PART 2**

#### **Baptism**

It is always with great joy to see sinners surrendering their lives to the Lord. We are happy to inform you that during the month in review, 16 souls obeyed the Gospel Truth and were baptized. We give all praise to the Lord!

#### **Preaching/Teaching**

The month of June saw us visiting rural congregations preaching and teaching the Bible. When we visited Ntabazinduna, brother Steve, Garry and Craig distributed food to the needy. Kids enjoyed a great deal when brother Garry gave them

candies. Brother Craig preached and six souls repented and indicated their willingness to be baptized. It took a great effort for us to look for waters of baptism and we finally managed to baptize five. We give all praise to God! When we visited Mtshabezi, brother Steve preached and he later converted a government official who was also baptized. Glory be to God!

#### **Bulawayo water woes**

Bulawayo Town Clerk has announced that from now onwards, water supply interruption may last up to four days throughout the city. He said this is due to the implementation of the African Development Bank funded pro-

ject whose objective is to improve municipal water supply and sanitation services. He added that when this project is complete, it will contribute to the improvement of the health and social wellbeing of the population of Bulawayo. This is a very difficult challenge which the city is facing because no one knows how long this water supply interruption will take. In some parts of the country, some farmers have already lost their livestock due to the shortage of water. We need your prayers so that Zimbabwe will be blessed with good rains this year.
