To Live Is Christ by Tim Dooley

While Paul is in prison he writes an impassioned plea to his beloved brothers and sisters in Philippi. He says that while dying would be most beneficial for him it was more needful for them that he remains alive; and that remaining alive, for him, is Christ (1:21-24). He desires that they too live their lives together as "worthy of the gospel of Christ" and that they "stand fast in one spirit" and strive together with "one mind" for "the faith of the gospel" (1:27). But just what does that life look like?

1. It suggests humbling ourselves and having the mind of Christ (2:2-8). Pride will lead to our destruction (Proverbs 16:18), but humility will lead to our exaltation (1 Peter 5:6).
2. It indicates being obedient and working out our own salvation (2:12). True, biblical faith always

acts (James 2)! Jesus' faith in the plan and operation of His Father lead him to "always do those things that please Him" (John 8:29). It is imperative for us to prove our love by being obedient (John 14:15)!

3. It points to doing all things without griping or complaining (2:14).
4. It implies rejoicing (3:1; 4:4).
5. It signifies never giving up (3:13-14; 4:1).
6. It means being thankful and thinking on the things that come from above (4:6-8).

What does continuing to live here on earth mean to you? Would you consider death to be gain? These two questions are inseparable. Have the mind of Christ my friends, and be faithful! [Tim]

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Report from Jacob and Nqobizitha

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ hoping this report finds everyone well and continuing steadfast in doing good for the glory of God, here the mortality rate continues to be high and most of our brethren sick we had to do hospital visits during the month giving our fellow brethren hope in Christ for we know nothing can separate us from the love of God Romans 8vs35-38.

On the first day of the week we worshipped with our local congregation encouraging one another in song, prayer and scripture.

The second week of the month we visited our Congregations in the Sigiti area sending 30 bags of Mealie meal to the Madonkini and Sigiti Churches

the area is one of the areas with little to almost no harvest most of the fields were swept or flattened by heavy rains. The brethren there sent messages to thank you very much for the continued support and love shown in the difficult times and may the Lord give back the measure pressed.

On the third week of the month one of our sisters in Christ lost a daughter who was buried in Sigiti about 65km from Bulawayo we helped in the funeral preaching hope in Christ and comforting the bereaved family and we also helped with the burial. We also had to rush one of our sisters in Christ sister Mathonsi on the same week to hospital we had to travel 70km to fetch her in rural areas to a medical institution in Bulawayo where she was admitted for three days we thank you for all the prayers.

The last week of the month we worked in a new drip irrigation garden, and we planted about 300 plants consisting of kale and onions. We wish to continue introducing the system that has saved lives in helping our brethren plant their own vegetables for food and also earn a bit of income to other areas and also win more souls as drip irrigation has also served as a very fruitful evangelism tool. Thank you very much for the support of the program.

On the last first day of the week we broke the bread with the combined Bulawayo Churches where we encouraged one another as the Bulawayo Churches of Christ to continue holding on to true doctrine.

Thank you very much for the support of all the work and everything done for His glory and may the Lord continue to strengthen our bond for all good works.
