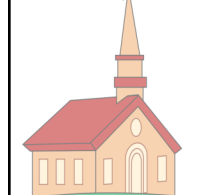

## IDLE HANDS *by Tim Dooley*

In 1 Kings 6-10 one witnesses the great work and wisdom of Solomon and the king is busy about the work of building a house for the Lord God of Israel. ## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Dear Brother Craig

Do you still remember Khulekani, the young preacher you met at Ntabazinduna, who is brother Gideon's son? We sent him to train as a preacher at Bear Valley Bible Institute in Gweru. Stella and I are paying fees for him and his wife. They are now attached at Stanhope Church of Christ for two months and have been preaching for the past three weeks. They converted 12 souls and we had to drive long distances along Gwayi river searching for water and found none. We fi-

nally decided to dig with shovels the riverbed for water. After scooping the sand for two hours, enough water for baptism gushed out. We were so happy. Brother Khulekani baptized them while being helped by brother Ncube. Oh! what a happy day! We gave all praise to the Lord! Please pray for these newly born babies in Christ for them to grow and be fruitful in the Lord. Our gospel beaver (truck) was overloaded and we had to drive 8kms slowly all the way to the river and back. People at the back of the truck sang all the way to baptism and back home. People along the way waved

their hands as we passed along. Oh! it was a happy day indeed!

The congregation at Stanhope will begin today to build a baptistery close to their church building. The funds for building the baptistery were provided by brother Steve Ellis during his recent visit to Zimbabwe. When completed it will save us from travelling for long distances looking for water.
