## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Report from Mthokozisi Sibanda

### NJUBE CONGREGATION

Our Mighty Lord has helped us to succeed in reaching out the lost and also penetrating even in the local community leadership meetings. On the 23rd of June we embark on a campaign called PICK IT UP. The youth went around picking up papers around Njube and Old Lobengula community in a way of keeping up our communities clean. The counselor helped us with brown gloves to use in our campaign. We also had free Bible correspondence we gave out to people who were passing by and 14 have so far handed their completed assignments.

### RADIO PROGRAM

The church is now widely known in Bulawayo because of being broadcasted. I preach live on Skyz

Metro Fm every Monday and Friday mornings. This local radio station has a following of almost 1 million people. On the 21 of June I was invited for alive discussion on Rape. I shared the stage with one attorney and one psychologist. Rape and sexual offenses are now a talk of day in our societies. I was asked to speak on

1. Religious aspect on why people go on to these serious crimes.
2. What does the church do if one of its members is a perpetrator?
3. Does the church do counseling on the rape victims and of the sexual abused?

These and more questions God helped to answer them even referring to the Bible.

### PRISON MINISTRY

On the 24th of June we visited Khami Medium and Khami Maximum Prisons. In Medium Prison, together with three preachers, we spoke to a large crowd of 300 inmates. We also gave out free WORLD BIBLE SCHOOL correspondence lessons to the 75 interested inmates and 8 prisons officers.

### REFRESHER COURSES

I trained and graduated in Zambia School of Biblical Studies in 2005. From that time I have been a full time minister of the Word of God in Njube church of Christ. On the 26th- 29th of June I attended a seminar organized for the former students. Theme was: And Having Done All to Stand....Eph 6:10-19. I spoke about standing on godly moral principles. This year's seminar was attended by 50 preachers from three different Southern African countries.... Botswana, Malawi, Zambia and Zimbabwe. In Him, Mthokozisi
