PREPARED FOR ETERNITY *by Tim Dooley*

Paul admonishes his readers that the life of a Christian is one that seeks to be pleasing to the Lord. This is true because we will all stand before the judgment seat of Christ and receive life or death according to the lives we have lived here on earth. *"Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men"* to live in such a way as to be prepared for that day (5:9-11). Here are some suggestions Paul makes to ensure we are prepared.

**BE A NEW CREATURE.** This means putting away our old ways and following the ways of the Lord (5:17).

**BE RECONCILED.** Sin separates us from God but the blood of Christ reunites us with Him (5:20-21).

**WORK TOGETHER.** There is much to do and we need to be working, with God, to bring as many souls to Christ as we can (6:1-2).

**BE NOT UNEQUALLY YOKED.** Being in fellowship with God and His children means being separate from those who walk in darkness. Remember you cannot serve both God and worldliness (6:14-17).

**HAVE GODLY SORROW (7:9-10).** There are a lot of people who are only sorry for their sins when they get caught. Godly sorry, true sorrow, will move one to make the necessary changes in his life.

**CLEANSE YOURSELF (7:1).**

Obedience to the gospel through faith, confession, repentance, and baptism is the beginning of our cleansing. Walking in the light and preparing for eternity allows the blood of Jesus to continue to cleanse us (Acts 22:16; 1 John 1:7) and keep us unto that day. Be faithful! [Tim]

Driving with food to each of these areas was just impossible and would take time since Binga is very far from Bulawayo and congregations far spaced in-between. The Saturday Preachers Refresher Workshop was very successful indeed. Two topics which were presented were Christian Evidences and Conflict Management. It was attended by 86 church leaders from rural and urban congregations. We give all praise to the Lord! However towards the end of the last session, brother Mbalekelwa Ncube (85) from Magwegwe West collapsed and died in my hands while we tried to resuscitate him to no avail. We then rushed him to Galan House Medical Centre some two km away with the hope that the medical staff would do something to resuscitate him but the doctor pronounced him already dead and could not do anything. It was so sad. We then took

the body to Mpilo Hospital mortuary. Ncube's family is very poor. We wish to assist this family with burial costs. We would appreciate if you may help this family with \$200.00.
