PROVE IT! (2 Corinthians 8-10) by Tim Dooley

2 Corinthians 8-9 primarily concern themselves with the collection to be taken up for the poor. Paul speaks to the liberality of the saints in Macedonia and how he had boasted of the love of the Corinthians. He also speaks to Titus' qualifications and trustworthiness to take possession of the money and deliver it.

In chapter 10 Paul's address changes so dramatically from the first nine chapters that many scholars believe that this is in fact a completely different letter. His condemnation is on those who questioned Paul's authority, appearance, and preaching style. These men sought to approve themselves and disprove Paul.

The import of all this is that what we as Christians should do all that we do not as unto men, but as to the Lord. We seek not the approval of men but seek to "prove ourselves" faithful to the Lord with whom we have to do. "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?" (2 Corinthians 13:5). "But let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another" (Galatians 6:4). "Prove all things; hold fast that which is good" (1 Thessalonians 5:21). Don't just say it, prove it! And be faithful. [Tim]

JULY 2018 MONTHLY REPORT: PART 1

Greetings from Zimbabwe in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We hope that this summary of the Lord's work for July 2018 will find you well and busy in His vineyard.

Teaching the Bible

In Zimbabwe, we still have many people who need to be taught the Gospel Truth. I preached at sister Dube's funeral in Nyamandlovu on Friday last week and read the following scriptures: Hebrews 9:27-28; Luke 16:22ff. and I Corinthians 15:35ff. All these scriptures point out that death is certain to all people, Christ will come again for those waiting for Him, resurrection and eternal life are all real. When the funeral was over, some religious men from an apostolic sect requested for these scriptures which I had read during my sermon and for more explanation. I sat down with them and took sometime explaining to them explicitly what the Bible teaches about death, resurrection and eternal life. They understood and

appreciated. What really surprised me was that they kept on telling me that these scriptures were new to them and wanted to find out more. All along I thought these scriptures were very familiar to religious preachers. This is clear proof that: "If the blind lead the blind, they will both fall into the pit." (Matthew 15:14). It is very possible for people to teach error or get lost while holding the Bible in their hands. This is why Paul urged Timothy to study and rightly handle the Word of God. (II Timothy 2:15). We all need some time to study the Bible and follow what it says and also teach it to others. The great commission is still valid today. "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations..." Matthew 28:19ff.

Preachers Refresher Course

This year's Preachers Refresher Course was a resounding success. It was attended by 87 church leaders. We discussed two topics mainly: Christian Evidence and Conflict Resolution. The lessons were

delivered by our visitors from the United States. On a sad note, one of the church leaders who attended this workshop brother Mbalekwa Dube(78), collapsed and passed on just before we concluded the studies. We laid him to rest at West Park Cemetery on Saturday. Please remember his family in your prayers. Brother Dorian Flynn assisted this family with funeral expenses. May our good Lord bless him.

One issue which resonated at this preachers workshop was the need for Ndebele Bibles in the rural congregations. Many people in the rural areas cannot read or understand English. Even in urban settings, when someone preaches in English, he is always assisted by an interpreter. So, we would really appreciate donations for Ndebele Bibles. This is a real need. These Ndebele Bibles will assist Christians especially in rural areas to read the Bible in their mother language and understand it.
