## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

### JULY 2017 UPDATE, PART 1

Greetings from Zimbabwe. We hope that you will enjoy reading a summary of our progress reports about the Lord's work in Zimbabwe during the month of July 2017.

In 2002, I came across the following quotation written by brother Alvin Jennings from Richland Hills Church of Christ, Fort Worth, Texas on the topic: We need to Open our Eyes. "If the Hebrew Christians needed to open their eyes and observe what was transpiring in their own lives, we are no less at risk than they were. Keep in mind that many of them had obeyed the gospel at Pentecost. Some thirty or so years had passed. They had been disheartened by

families, scorned by friends and treated as turncoats to the Jewish religion. By now some of them had grown weary. Their faith was being sorely tested.

There was real danger that they would fall away from the gospel and return to the allurements of the world or that they would renounce their faith in Christ and go back to Judaism. The book of Hebrews was written precisely for their situation to prevent apostasy and to encourage them to faithfulness. The writer sounded the theme in the word "better", with better covenant, better priesthood and better promises. He warned them to "take heed" i.e. to be watchful, lest they should have an evil heart of unbelief in falling away from the living God." Similarly, Paul encourages us to take heed or open our eyes to the real purpose of our existence. "But none of these things

move me; nor do I count my life dear to myself, so that I may finish my race with joy, and the ministry which I received from the Lord Jesus, and to TESTIFY to the gospel of the grace of God." Acts 20:24.
