Be Not Ignorant of His Devices

In 2 Corinthians 11 the Apostle Paul wrote that while the church was to be betrothed to Christ as a chaste virgin he was afraid that Satan would corrupt their minds through subtle craftiness, even as he had Eve, from the simplicity that is in Christ (1:1-4). Satan is a deceiver (Revelation 12:9), a liar and a murderer (John 8:44). So in 2 Corinthians 2:11 Paul reminds us that there is no need to be ignorant of his ways. Satan will use any means possible to deceive us and drag our souls into eternal punishment with him. While we know these things intellectually we often lapse in our awareness and diligence. We let down our guard and allow him to have his way with us.

Here are just a few things to keep in mind as we continue to strive to live faithfully to the one to whom we have entrusted our souls. We it comes to Satan and evil we must remember that...

HE MAKES SIN ATTRACTIVE. Yes, it is ugly to God, but Satan blinds our eye to just how ugly sin is by making it *appear* attractive and pleasurable. Illicit carnal pleasures come with the devastating consequences of unwanted pregnancies, disease, broken homes, and mental distresses. Drugs and alcohol offer an *escape from reality* and a *high*. Yet the minions of Satan want you to believe that this is *living* when the consequences are physically and spiritually devastating. Yes, there is indeed instant gratification and pleasure in sin. If sin were instantaneously harmful few would engage in it. Satan, the great deceiver, makes sin attractive.

HE GOES TO CHURCH. I understand that the church is not someplace we go but who we are. But do not be deceived...Satan is often among us. He shows up at Bible Study and worship. He is there at youth events and the Ladies Bible Class. He is not above presenting himself before God in the midst of God's children (Job 1:6-7). He is in the midst of the eldership (Acts 20:28-31). He is in the pulpit (Galatians 1:8-9). Be not ignorant of the fact that Satan goes to church.

HE URGES US TO PROCRASTINATE. Satan would never tell the prospect that they should "just say no." He never suggests that we abandon our responsibilities. To be so blunt would immediately put any intelligent person on guard and suspicious. No, rather than do that Satan suggests that we just put off doing what we know we should. He tells us we have plenty of time, we are already doing more than our share, that just believing is enough. There is no more deadly deceit than the Devil's suggestion that we drag your feet. All the while he is dragging our feet into eternal flames of hell.

Satan does not manifest himself in the hideous personification of the artist's rendering. He appears as an angel of light (2 Corinthians 11:14). He is a deceiver and a liar. Be not ignorant of his devices. Ultimately we will all do one of two things: We will either allow God to have His way with us or we will let Satan. Why would anyone forgo the loving hand of Christ to hold on to the lying, murderous hand of Satan?

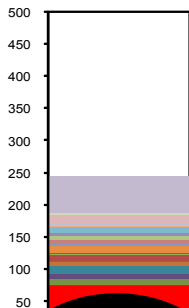
