Christian Toughness *by Mike Johnson*

How do you judge another person's toughness? Is it the size and strength of their muscles? Is it through the strength of their character? Or, do you see toughness primarily in one's temperament? Probably all of us use all three of these things to render a judgment about someone's toughness. However, I think we can all agree, from the Christian perspective that toughness is about how much control of your own life you are willing to give up in order to rely on God.

This toughness comes first from recognizing and accepting God's will for life. Paul asked the Corinthians a rhetorical question in 2 Corinthians 1:17, "Therefore, when I was planning this, did I do it lightly? Or the things I plan, do I plan according to the flesh..." For anyone familiar with Paul's life, the answer is a resounding, "NO!" Paul's entire motivation was to follow the will of God. His own words, not in arrogance, said, "Imitate me just as I

imitate Christ." (1 Corinthians 11:1)

Toughness then rests in God's promises. Paul continues to the Corinthians, "For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen to the glory of God through us." (2 Corinthians 1:20) Jesus was the culmination of all of God's will from the beginning of time. His fulfillment of God's promise to send Him to deal with the sin problem (Genesis 3:15), verified that all of God's promises are true.

Finally, toughness depends on our constant renewal through God's principles. Again, Paul continues in the same context, "Now He who establishes us with you in Christ..." (2 Corinthians 1:21). This is the same principle as going to the gym to maintain what you have achieved in previous work. It is a constant process. By reminding ourselves of the principles of God that are always at work, we stay tough to face the challenges that are sure to come.
