Happy Anniversary

Last week we marked the 5-year anniversary of my family and I moving to work with the Point Pleasant family (You'll have to ask Buddy for the specific date J). We have seen the family here grow in number and faith, we have seen some new souls added to our fellowship, lost a few dear friends and family members to moves and eternity. And while the past five years have been seen numerous highs and lows which have been forever impressed upon our memories and have had a lasting effect upon our identity, in the famous words of Ronny Milsap, "I wouldn't have missed it for the world!"

We have many plans, hopes, and ongoing works to attend to. Some will have to be re-imagined, other will be put on hold, and some will reap eternal glory for the Lord. Let us ever be diligent (Hebrews 4:11) in keeping our hands on the plow, moving on, keeping our sights on the eternal prize (Luke 9:62; Philippians 3:12)! While none of us know what the future holds for us in this life we our confident in what eternity holds for the obedient and faithful child of God. As great as things have been in the past five years I believe we all have room to grow and improve. With that in mind I want to ask you, my spiritual family for a few things:

Pray For Me: I need and covet your prayers. I want to be a better husband, father, friend, brother, Christian, and preacher. I want to be blessed in order to be strong, bold, and faithful in proclaiming the precious message of God. I can do better at all those things and I know that the effectual, fervent prayers of my righteous spiritual family can help me with all these things (James 5:16).

Forgive Me: I know I am not perfect (far from it!) and I have on occasion let folks down. I have not always said or did the right things. I have failed you in the past, but I want you to know that I never want to fail you and don't intend to. But I am only a man, saved by the blood of Christ, and striving to be faithful to my calling. I need your forgiveness as well as God's (2 Corinthians 2:7, 10; Ephesians 4:32).

Love Me and My Family: There is no greater encouragement, besides the first two things I have enumerated here, that the brethren can do but show their love, support, and understanding to their minister. The preacher's job is often a lonely one, a stressful one, a frustrating one. His wife shares his burdens and feels his pain. His children are not perfect, but then again whose are? Love them (John 13:34; 1 Thessalonians 4:9; 1 Peter 1:22).

Support the Preaching of the Truth: The faithful gospel preacher wants nothing more than to devotedly proclaim the saving message of God to mankind. Don't be afraid to stand with him when the truth is proclaimed and don't be afraid to lovingly question or correct when it is not. If his heart is right he will thank you for both! And when appropriate respond to the message, as it is intended, obedient unto God. The preacher is not (or should not be) preaching his own wisdom but the wisdom that is from above. Respond accordingly!

I believe that God is active! The lives each of us have lived have brought us together in this time and place in order that we might be able to bring other souls to the cross and do great things for God, to bring Him and the church of our Lord glory and honor. That's all I want. Help me, help you, and together we can continue to do great things for as long as God allows us to be together here. I love you all! Be faithful! [Tim]

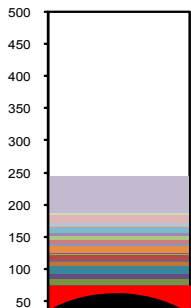

Update from Velaphi Melangani

“The Rainbow congregation is working to continue the support for our WBS work in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe. This work has been going on since 2002. Several congregations continue to support us while other have needed to drop their support. We are in dire need of additional support.Rainbow needs additional support to keep our work going in Zimbabwe. Many good things are coming from the work in the name of Jesus Christ and we want to continue that. At the present time, land has been given to the church to open up an elementary school for the children. A medical clinic is also being opened up in the name of Christ. We could go on and on about the present work, but Christ is being preached and souls are being converted. If you know any congregation that might be willing to support the work, let them know about it. We will also be willing to contact them if you give us their names. Our goal is to keep everything going just as it is in Bulawayo, pray to God fervently and give Him the glory for what is done. The elders at Rainbow are willing to answer any questions you may have on the budget. Brother Velaphi sends us a detailed report of expense each month.
