### The Right Response by Tim Dooley

The theme for "Polishing the Pulpit" this year was "Refresh, Renew, Recharge." This year was the first chance I had to go to "Polishing the Pulpit" and I am so thankful to my Point Pleasant family for making it possible for me to go. The timing was perfect! This past week was exactly what I needed.

I got to spend some time visiting with some good friends and was able to make some new ones as well as touching base with some that I had not seen for many years. One thing that always encourages me is to see people you have not seen in years and know that they are still faithful to the Lord.

I was able to gather some good material and learn a few things that I can apply to my life and my ministry. I also was able to rekindle the fire to learn the language of the Bible so that I might better understand God's revelation and teach others. And that brings me to the subject of what I most gained from this past week.

I got to hear my old friend Eric Owens on several occasions. Brother Owens is a fantastic speaker, a godly man and a scholar. He reminded me that the Bible is not just a revelation "from" God; it is the revelation "of" God Himself to mankind. From the Creation Account to His relationship with Abraham; from Moses and Israel to the Advent of Christ and His life, death, burial, and resurrection; from the foundation and beginning of the church to the last letter penned by the apostles and prophets upon whom He breathed, the Bible declares who God is and this is how we should approach the reading of God's Word. Every ancient symbol of inspiration shouts, "God did that!"

Our Lord is great! Our God is indeed an awesome God!

The question for all of us to consider, in light of the fact that God has revealed himself to us and loved us with such an amazing kind of love (John 3:16; 1 John 3:16-17), is how should we respond to Him?

There are only three possible responses:

**Rejection.** This is hard to imagine in light of what God has done for us but it is, has always been and probably always will be, the response given by the largest number. The Rich Young Ruler wanted to know from Christ what the proper response to God's love was. He wanted to know what he needed to do in order to inherit eternal life. Jesus responded, "Sell all that you have and distribute to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow Me." But the young man went away intensely saddened because he was rich. He rejected God's love for the love of the world (Luke 18:18-23).

**Indifference.** The second largest group consists of those who come to Jesus to receive eternal life but never give up the world for Him. Jesus likens this group to "thorny soil" that chokes the life out of the believer's heart. Jesus identifies the thorns as "the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches" (Matthew 13:22). When we read the words of Christ to the church at Laodicea we see that this is exactly what happened to them (Revelation 3:14-18).

**Complete Sacrifice.** The smallest group, but the most blessed! In Matthew 13 Jesus follows up the parable of the soils with two other pertinent parables: The Hidden Treasure and the Pearl of Great Price (verses 44-46). Notice the proper response to the love of God. They gave all!

2 Corinthians 13:5 says to "Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves." So dare we?

Ask yourself these questions: What kind of soil am I? How have I responded to the love of God? Have I given all? What do I need to do next? What do I need to do right now?

Be faithful! [Tim]
