**The God of All Blessings** *by Tim Dooley*

For a basic understanding of the letter to the church at Ephesus one can simply divide the book in half. In the first three chapters we consider what God has done for us. He has blessed us with all spiritual blessings (1:3); predestined us (1:5); made us acceptable, redeemed, and forgiven (1:6-7); Made known to us the mystery of his will (1:9); gave us an inheritance (1:11); made us alive from the dead (2:1); gave us a place to sit with Christ (2:6); brought us near to Him by the blood of Christ (2:13); made us citizens of His kingdom (2:19); and gave us knowledge through the written, inspired word (3:4).

In chapters four through six Paul then enumer-

ates what our response to God's love should be. We are to walk worthy (4:1); keep the unity of the Spirit (4:3); put off the old man and put on the new (4:22-24); work to give (4:28); be kind (4:32); have no fellowship with darkness (5:6-12); Be understanding of God's will and be filled with the spirit (5:15-18); Be thankful and submissive (5:20-21); and conduct yourself as a faithful Christian in every earthly relationship (5:21-6:9). Finally, brethren, be strong and put on the whole armor of God.

Considering what God has done for us, how should we respond to Him? Be faithful [Tim]

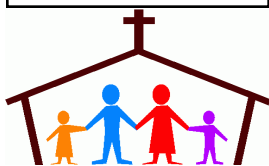

### **Report from Jacob and Nqobizitha**

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, hoping this report finds everyone well. We would like to thank you very much for all the support in the Lord's work here in Zimbabwe which has helped us spread the Gospel Matthew 28:19, everything done so that the name of our Lord can be glorified.

In the first week of the month, we worshipped with our local Congregation, encouraging one another in hymns, scripture and in prayer. On the second week of the month, we had a Gospel Revival meeting in Zhilo about 100km out of Bulawayo, it is with great joy to let you brethren know that our rural work continues to grow, our fellow rural Christians continue holding on to the true Gospel of our Lord (1 Corinthians 15:1-4.) We also visited drip irrigation gardens in Bayethe. Drip irrigation farming continues saving lives of many of our rural brethren who

continue to work hard in their gardens. Drip irrigation farming has also served as a tool to evangelize in the rural areas and has saved many souls. The third week of the month, we broke the bread with our brethren in Bulawayo vicinity as we had our combined Bulawayo Churches of Christ fellowship it is so humbling to see that the Church here in Zimbabwe continues to be united. On the last week of the month we travelled to Mazikhelela in the Mtshabazi area about 110km south of Bulawayo we also distributed 30 bags of Mealie meal to our needy rural brethren, they sent messages to say thank you very much for the charity you give them in their time of need, May the Lord bless all of you.

Thank you very much for the hard work you continue to do that side it always motivates us to want to do more for our Lord every day, we sincerely appreciate. We pray that the Lord will continue to strengthen our bond for all good works so that the name of our father in heaven can be glorified. Love to all, Nqobizitha / Jacob
