The Lord Has Done Great Things *by Tim Dooley*

It never ceases to amaze me how some Christians view their accomplishments. Lip service is often given when glorifying the Lord but arrogance and self-righteousness abound. The lips of so many are dripping with hypocrisy, they say one thing but do something else.

The psalmist reminds us that it is the Lord who accomplishes great things through His humble servants (Psalm 126-130). And though we diligently watch and labor, if not for the Lord, our labor and watching is in vain. We may build great houses but only those built by the Lord will remain.

We need to remember two things when it comes to our human and spiritual accomplishments:

Just because something "good" happens from a humanistic standpoint doesn't mean God has blessed that effort or that it was God's plan. The Bible is replete of stories of successful human endeavors of which God

was not pleased. I have seen men appointed to the eldership who were not qualified and folks praised the move as providential. Congregations of the Lord's church have left the "old paths" in an effort to be more contemporary and inclusive to the chagrin of God. We need to be careful not to determine something as God's will if it runs contrary to God's will.

When truly good, God blessed events are accomplished, make sure we give the praise and glory to God. Let us remove from our language the self praise of "I did," or "we did" and acknowledge what God has done through His humble servants.

Let us give credit and glory where it is due, unto the Lord. For He has done great things! The faithful and obedient child of God will be blessed beyond measure. Be faithful! [Tim]

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

THIS MESSAGE WAS INCLUDED IN VELAPHI'S JULY REPORT FROM AN FELLOW PREACHER: "Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Hoping everyone is well as we continue to work in the Lord's vineyard. Thanking God for allowing us to work in His field and for the love that He has bestowed in us all.

PRISON MINISTRY

Njube congregation leads a team of men and women monthly who go and present the good news to Khami Prison, which is 27 km north west of Bulawayo. There are so many successful stories there. The most exciting one is when the 19 inmates and many prison officials there asked us to plant a New Testament church. On the 14th of July we went there and held a service with them though there are strict rules on how we should conduct our worship services.

One inmate by the name of Tafirenyika whom we baptized and has served 9 years in jail said when he is released wants to train as a preacher for the churches of Christ. He comes from Plumtree Town 100 km west of Bulawayo

YOUTH AND CHILDREN CLASSES

We have highly qualified and spiritually filled personnel who are directly dealing with these delicate classes. Just last Sunday we baptized 5 youths whom we nurtured since there we in their 4th grade. We also baptized a 63 year old woman who was brought in by her grand child. These kids are amazing ..God is using them to bring even the old people.

GOOD NEWS: Our ward Counselor has offered his office grounds to start a kids club for the community...spear headed by us Njube Church of Christ.. So Amazing!! In Him, Mthokozisi Sibanda"
