IDLENESS!

In Exodus 36–40 we read of the instructions and the building of the tabernacle. It seems like whenever the children of Israel stayed busy doing the work of God they remained faithful. However, it is also true that whenever they were idle they seemed to begin to grumble, complain, and sin. The simple truth is that as long as they were busy doing the Lord’s work their hearts and minds stayed focused and occupied upon the work of the Lord and they had n time to sin.

Now, lest we be too hard on the Israelite people, we need to consider that this truth is common for all mankind and is true of us as well. Does being idle lead to sinfulness? Is there any virtue in being busy about the Lord’s work?

We need to be honest with ourselves and accept the fact that often times our idleness is the cause of our struggles. In Proverbs 19:15 we read, “Laziness casts into a deep sleep, and an idle man will suffer hunger.” The author of Ecclesiastes says, “Because of laziness the building decays, And through idleness of hands the house leaks” (Ecclesiastes 10:18). Sure, there are circumstances that are beyond our control but far too often troubles simply arise our of a lack of attention.

Secondly, idleness leads to sinfulness. In 1 Timothy 5:13 the apostle Paul speaks of those who “learn to be idle, wandering about from house to house, and not only idle but also gossips and busybodies, saying things which they ought not.” Like the children of Israel, when we are idle, we often find time to do the devil’s work instead of the Lord’s. As the old saying goes, “Idle hands are the devil’s workshop.”

Lastly, idleness means that the work of the Lord is neglected and souls are lost. Jesus commanded, “Do you not say, ‘There are still four months and then comes the harvest’? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest” (John 4:35). In the Parable of the Laborers Jesus said that the owner of the household went out in the eleventh hour and “found others standing idle, and saith unto them, ‘Why stand ye here all the day idle?’” (Matthew 20:6). When we are idle we are neglecting the work of the Lord and souls are being lost.
