**THE GOODNESS AND SEVERITY OF GOD (Nahum) by Tim Dooley**

120 years after the city of Nineveh repented at the preaching of Jonah God raised another prophet, but this time they would not repent. In 612 BC the city of Nineveh was destroyed. Within 50 years Nineveh was utterly annihilated and wiped from the face of the earth only to be rediscovered in the mid-nineteenth century.

The importance of this message lies in the fact that God is righteous and he will not allow the wicked to go unpun-

ished. He is also good and a strong hold to them that trust in him. Trust indicates obedience, reliance, and faithfulness. God is both good and severe, so we must learn to obey and trust him and live. The Apostle Paul reminds us to "consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off" (Romans 11:22).

### JULY MONTHLY REPORT: PART 3

#### Zimbabwe Economy

Zimbabwe's annual inflation rate, which stood at 5,39 percent in September last year, has continued to rise, reaching a post-dollarisation record of 175,66 percent last month. Economists are giving contradictory reasons for this. None of which are convincing but all is just rigmarole. The price of bread is now between four and seven dollars per loaf depending on where you buy it and 'if' you can get it. Life here is really very difficult - no electricity, no water, no fuel but our Lord is giving us strength to soldier on. Please continue praying for Zimbabwe. When God answers your prayers,

we shall smile again.

#### Conclusion

We once again thank you our loving brothers and sisterd in Canada and the United States for your unwavering support for the Lord's work in Zimbabwe. We are doing this much and winning many lost souls because of your support. May the Lord continue blessing you.
