Recently, I have been reminded of the incredible frailty of life. Death is the great equalizer. It doesn't care about your plans. It doesn't care how much money you have or what you do for a living. It doesn't care about your goals and dreams. It doesn't even care if you are ready. When it comes, and it will, the only thing that matters is what you have done to prepare for the next life and what you leave behind.

There have been more people in this life that were forgotten after their death than have been remembered. People who were once important, albeit, even vital, to society are now forgotten names on a tombstone somewhere. While that sounds fairly sad, I'm not disheartened by this fact, for I imagine for a great deal of them the legacy of what they taught others lives on, whether their names do or not. This is really what life is all about. So often in this busy life we forget that it isn't about dollar and cents. It isn't about big houses and fine cars. In fact, this life isn't about this one at all...it's about doing what we can to get to the next.

When I die, I don't care if anyone remembers my name. I don't care if they remember a single sermon I preached, or a conversation we had. I hope they remember me as someone who tried his best to get them to Heaven with me. I hope they remember that I strived everyday to make sure each person I met was on the right path and I hope they will strive to continue that.

The only way I can leave that kind of legacy behind is if I live that kind of life now. If I die, and I didn't do everything I could to make sure that everyone I know makes it to Heaven, if I die with any effort left in the tank for helping others, then I will have failed. And since death has no date book, that means leaving a legacy every single day. So when I pass on, don't mourn for me. Skip the flowers and cards and if you really want to do something, pick up where I leave off, succeed where I have failed, carry on what I leave behind. Teach your children to do the same and, one day, they may not remember our names, but they'll remember what we left behind.
