**To Live Is Christ** by Tim Dooley

While Paul is imprisoned he writes an impassioned plea to his beloved brothers and sisters in Philippi. He says that while dying would be most beneficial for him it was more needful for them that he remains alive; and that remaining alive, for him, is Christ (Philippians 1:21-24). He desires that they too live their lives together as it "becomes the gospel of Christ" and that they "stand fast in one spirit" and strive together with "one mind" for "the faith of the gospel" (1:27).

What does that life look like?

It suggests humbling ourselves and having the mind of Christ (2:2-8).

It indicates being obedient and working out our own salvation (2:12).  
It points to doing all things without griping or complaining (2:14).  
It implies rejoicing (3:1; 4:4).  
It signifies never giving up (3:13-14; 4:1).  
It means being thankful and thinking on the things that come from above (4:6-8).

What does continuing to live here on earth mean to you? Would you consider death to be gain? These two questions are inseparable. Be faithful. [Tim]

### AUGUST 2018 MONTHLY REPORT: PART 1

The Churches of Christ in Zimbabwe send their greetings!

The month of August 2018 was full of church activities. This clearly shows that the Lord's church in Zimbabwe is alive and growing. The help which our loving brothers and sisters in Canada and the United States are giving us in propagating the Gospel is bearing much fruit. May the Lord receive all glory!

On this note, my brother Ronald Bailey who is in Canada said: "2018 has reminded me that when it is our time to leave this body, no one can stop it. We have one life to live. The material things we invest in are left behind only to be discarded." In other words, life is not solely about material acquisition. I remember in 1969 when I went to train to be a preacher at

Nhowe Bible School, there was 'a must pass subject' called Personal Work or How to win lost souls. We dealt with three questions namely: "Where do we come from? Why are we here and where do we go from here?" "On why are we here? Many in our modern society believe that we are here to "Eat, Drink and Be Merry". This view is also known as utilitarian individualism. We can define it in terms of personal pleasure, happiness or accumulation. You might have heard such expressions as: "Go for the gusto" and "You go around only once." The real meaning of this is that life is determined by the amount of pleasure, power or things. I once saw a bumper sticker written: "The one who dies with the most toys wins." But those among us who are much older know precisely well that enough is never enough. The more a person has, the more he wants. The toys we accumulate satisfy us for only a very short period

and man never reaches the real satisfying goal of his existence by having these numerous toys. I totally agree with my brother Ronald Bailey. When you live for the accumulation of these toys, you will miss the mark because when you die, your toys "will be discarded". Is that what we should live for? Absolutely not! We should live for Christ and continue walking in His footsteps. Christ said: "I came to sick and save the lost". Luke 19:10. There is so much joy and satisfaction when we spend our lives, time and resources in seeking and saving the lost. Nothing is greater than this! The spiritual life finds its highest fulfillment in the love of God for His people and Christ for His church. There is absolutely nothing wrong in having or striving for this and that, but our priority should always be about the Lord's Work or His Kingdom ( Daniel 12:2-3). (to be continued)
