It's Not My Fault (2 Thessalonians) by Tim Dooley

It has been human nature since the beginning of time to blame our own failures on something or someone else. Taking personal responsibility is an ever-waning virtue. Some Bible readers get caught up on the "strong delusion" passage in 2 Thessalonians 2:11-12 and want to blame God on for their sins and failures. However, the over-arching context of the Bible tells us several things:

1. God loves everyone and wants everyone to be saved (*John 3:16; Acts 17:30-31; Titus 2:11*).
2. God is a God of truth and honesty (*Deuteronomy 32:4*).
3. Every accountable man has a free moral agency (*1 Corinthians 10:13; Matthew 11:28-30*).

What Paul is telling the Christians at Thessalonica is that:

1. When the Lord comes he will take vengeance on those who have "chosen" not to know God or have "chosen" not to obey the Lord (1:7-9).
2. They were not to allow themselves to be deceived (2:2).
3. They keep themselves pure and undefiled, not allowing the unrighteous to continue in their midst that they might be also drawn away.

If you want to believe the lies of Satan, you will. God's love for us allows for each of us to choose to either love him or not. What do you choose? Be faithful. [Tim]
