**Do These Things** *by Tim Dooley*

In Zechariah's prophetic message of encouragement to the people of Israel (Zechariah 6-10) he tells them to do four things. 1) Speak truth to your neighbor; 2) Execute truth and peace in your gates; 3) Do not imagine evil in your hearts against your neighbor; and 4) Do not love a false oath. It is important to remember that the Lord's blessings upon His people are conditional upon their willingness to live according to His will.

The application here for us is that we are not only to be truthful in our dealings but we are also to speak the Lord's truth to all with whom come into contact. Sec-

### **AUGUST PROGRESS REPORT, PART 2**

Report from Siphon Nkala: MacDonald Church of Christ August 2017 Report.
