Many here at the Point Pleasant congregation (especially the children) are aware that my daughter Rachel has been selling suckers for a school fundraiser. Typically we begin our purchase with one specific purpose, "Do you have a flavor I like?" We search through the bag in order to find those suckers that meet our approval and make our selection.

Sometimes it is possible to make the wrong selection. This became apparent to me today. Wednesday evening one of the children handed me a "Banana Split" flavored sucker. Knowing I had one of these here on my desk I graciously offered it to brother Daryl. Now I wish I had given him both of them...YUCK!

In all seriousness this is how some folks make choices with regard to their spiritual lives. They search through the "bag of churches" to select one that is most palatable and pleasing to them. Some folks search the "bag of lifestyles" to find one that best suits their desires. Some may look good and even sound good, but the wrong choice leaves us with a bad taste in our mouths. But these choices also lead to eternal consequences.

In Num. 36:6 we read, "This is what the LORD commands concerning the daughters of Zelophehad, saying, 'Let them marry whom they think best, but they may marry only within the family of their father's tribe.'" Now consider the choices these women had; they could choose to marry anyone they liked, as long as the husband was chosen from their father's tribe or they could choose to marry anyone they wanted outside the tribe. God doesn't force anyone to do what He says, but He doesn't leave us without the necessary information regarding the consequences either.

What do you think these girls did? In verse twelve we learn that, "They were married into the families of the children of Manasseh the son of Joseph, and their inheritance remained in the tribe of their father's family." So they made wise choices and the inheritance stayed in the family. What do you think would have happened if they had married outside of the tribe God authorized? That's right, they would have lost the inheritance as well as have fallen out of favor with God.

What happens when we go against what God says? When we "choose the church of our choice" or we make a "lifestyle choice" neither of which are pleasing to God? I hear people all the time say things like, "God would want me to be happy" or "That's not what God has in store for me." The fact is God has given us, within His predetermined parameters, "all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of [Christ]" (2 Pet. 1:3).

A dear friend of mine recently left her husband, the church and the faith for which she once so earnestly contended (Jude 3). I hope she reads this and realizes the foolishness of her choices. I hope she realizes how much Christ loves her and that He died for her and how her choices are hurting Him. I hope she realizes how hurt and concerned her family and friends are for her soul and just how much they love her and care about her. I hope she knows that we are all praying for her with tears. I pray that she doesn't waste too much of her life, she has been such a great soldier in the kingdom of Christ. I hope that she comes back home before it is too late.

Make wise, godly choices. Be faithful. [Tim]
