What Would You Give? by Tim Dooley

It is an unequivocal truth that all men will stand before God in judgment (Romans 14:10; 2 Corinthians 5:10). But the condition in which we find ourselves standing before God will dictate whether or not we are granted entrance into the heavenly home prepared for us (John 14:1-3) or are cast into an eternal punishment in hell, a place "prepared for the devil and his angels" (Matthew 25:41).

Jesus makes it clear that in order to enter into eternal life one must forsake all and follow him (Mark 8:34). He goes on to ask, "For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?" (Mark 8:36-37). Even if

you could amass all the riches of the entire world you would not be able to exchange them on the Judgment Day for eternal life. In fact, if you had amassed all the world's wealth you would not have it available to exchange because it would all have been burned up (2 Peter 3:10). The old adage is certainly true, "You can't take it with you!" (See Job 1:21).

Unless one is found covered in the blood of Jesus when he stands before God in judgment he will not inherit eternal life. But if we will leave the things of this world, Jesus promises us a hundred fold more in this life and "in the world to come eternal life" (Mark 10:30).
