Keep Your Heart with All Diligence by Paolo Di Luca

We live in a very materialistic and hedonistic society completely concentrated on pleasing self and instant gratification. Most of us are accustomed to a much higher level of luxury, comfort and security than our ancestors. Material possessions are believed to be the prominent deliverers of happiness and satisfaction. Many believe the mistaken concept that if they just acquire certain things, then they can be truly happy and even secure. So, as a result, people develop their own agendas by which they seek to climb the ladder of success and/or happiness.

As Christians, we are called to be different from the world and to reject all those humanistic notions that are in opposition to God: "Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him" (1 John 2:15; cf. John 15:19; Rom. 12:2; 1 John 3:1). However, Satan is often successful in deceiving the heart of believers and instigating them to accept the influence of the world around them. Knowing all this, the wise godly father gives this instruction to his children: "Keep your heart with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life" (Prov. 4:23)

The Holy Scriptures clearly teach that the real issues of life are spiritual and that, in reality, they are matters of the heart, of the inner man. It should not surprise anyone that noun *heart* is found so many times in the Bible: 835 times in 775 different verses (NKJV). The *heart* is a very prominent concept in the entire Bible. Most often it is used metaphorically to refer to the mind, to the emotions, to the will, to the total inner man, or just to the person as a whole reality. As demonstrated by the quantity of passages, the term *heart* is so important to God because He is so very deeply concerned about the spiritual condition of the inner man.

"But the LORD said to Samuel, 'Do not look at his appearance or at his physical stature, because I have refused him. For the LORD does not see as man sees; for man looks at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart'" (1 Sam. 16:7). "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked; who can know it? I, the LORD, search the heart, I test the mind, even to give every man according to his ways, according to the fruit of his doings" (Jer. 17:9-10). These two passages clearly affirm that the Lord looks at and searches the inner person or the heart from which proceed all our actions, our desires, our hopes, etc. (Prov. 4:23; Matt. 6:21; 12:34; 15:18). All that we do in word and in deed is the product of who we are inside, of how is our heart. Jesus teaches that adultery begins in the heart (Matt. 5:28). One may not have literally committed adultery, but when that one, in his own heart, desires that illegitimate physical relation, he has already committed adultery.

Our obedience to God and our walk with Him is always a matter of the heart. In fact the great physician, the Lord Jesus Christ, has provided for His disciples the means to model and shape their hearts through the healing action of the spiritual scalpel of His word: "For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Heb. 4:12).
