MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Greetings from Zimbabwe! I am convinced that you will enjoy this September 2016. While walking along Manhattan street in New York in the United States in 1989, I came across a vendor who was selling books. I quickly looked at these books and among them was a Lexicon Webster's Dictionary. I was attracted to this huge voluminous encyclopaedic edition of 1,230 pages containing 170,000 entries. I then picked this book and as I perused through it, I noticed that it contained 32 sparkling pages in full color on Who is Who on the Presidency of the United States of America. One

conspicuous thing which startled me was that among all chosen Presidents from George Washington in 1789 to George Herbert Bush in 1989, there was not a single woman President. I wondered why. I was among a group of journalists from many countries sponsored by the United States Information Service to visit television stations in the United States and learn from their operations. As we travelled from Washington to Los Angeles, I was privileged in meeting several Congressmen. In our discussions, not a single one gave me a satisfactory answer as to why Americans shun women when choosing presidents to run their
