Getting Into The Bible *by Jason T Carter*

There was a young boy who took a creative writing class. One of his first assignments was to imagine what it would be like to read a book and then be magically transported into that book. When his younger brother heard this, he immediately started thinking about “getting into” a book about Thomas the Tank Engine. He placed his Thomas book on the floor and stepped on it, but that didn’t work. Then he picked up the book, placed it on the couch, and put his head against it, trying to “get into” it, but that didn’t work either. He just couldn’t “get into” the book like his brother did.

We all must try to “get into” the greatest book ever written: the Bible. No, we can’t physically step into it or be magically transported into it, but we should try to use our imagination to “get into” it. We should read with understanding and apply what we read to our lives. We should take the words of the prophets of old and the inspired writers of the New Testament, and find out how we measure up to what they have written.

Read the first chapter of Genesis, and imagine yourself there with God as He created the world. Read about Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden, Cain and Abel as they presented their offerings to the Almighty, Moses as he received the Law on Mt. Sinai, and imagine yourself there as these events unfolded.

Study the gospel accounts, as Jesus taught the multitudes and told the parables. Imagine yourself listening to those parables for the first time, as if you were among the many who were thirsting for His words. “Get into” His teachings.

Examine Paul’s instructions to the saints in Rome, Corinth, Ephesus, and all the other local congregations. Study them in light of the entire New Testament and apply those principles and commands to your life so that you can serve God in the way He wants to be served.

James, the half-brother of our Lord, wrote about “getting into” the Word of God. He said, “Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls. But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man observing his natural face in the mirror, for he observes himself, goes away, and immediately forgets what kind of man he was. But he who looks into the perfect law of liberty and continues in it, and is not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in what he does” (James 1:21-25).
