The Most Difficult Word in the New Testament by Ben Wright

There are many things in the New Testament I have a hard time following. Not because they are difficult to understand, but because they are hard to do. It seems though, that the root of them all stems from a single word found in Matthew 28:19-20, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age." Can you guess which word is the most difficult in the New Testament? "Observe". Jesus told them to, not only make disciples, not just to teach, but to teach them to "observe".

It's a difficult word because it costs us something, or at least, it should. It costs us time, money, energy. It can cost us relationships or feelings. It's difficult because it is not passive. It's more than sitting in a pew and listening. It means we have to get up and get out. Frankly, I struggle with it.

I've been trying to lose a few pounds lately. In my struggle over the years to do so, I can tell you all about various weight loss programs and diets I have learned about. I can talk to you about low-carb diets, points programs, even exercise regimens. I'm no expert, of course, but I could soundly discuss all of these things for a significant amount of time. My problem isn't knowledge; it's observing that things I know.

Isn't the true test of Christianity not what we know, but what we do with that knowledge? Studying Scripture and discussing it is great, necessary even; but isn't it really about living what we know? Wasn't "doing" a big difference between the wise man and the foolish man, (Matthew 7:24-27). Wasn't this James' point, as well, (James 1:22-25)? In my life I seem to be very good at talking about these things, but I have a much harder time observing them. What if that changed? What if we focused as much time being doers as we do being hearers?

The real essence of the great commission was not to create disciples solely for the purpose of creating knowledge, but it was to instill in them the knowledge of Jesus to move them to change their world by their actions. Christians are called to be active in our faith, not passive. We are called to be doers, not just hearers. All the Biblical knowledge in the world is nearly useless if we fail to "observe" what it is we have been taught.

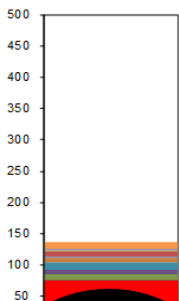
