Forgiveness and Brotherhood by Tim Dooley

In the shortest of all Paul's letters we have some great and practical advice. Paul sends Onesimus (traditionally thought to have been Philemon's slave) back to Philemon with this letter asking him to receive Onesimus, not as a slave, but as a brother in Christ.

Several points for us to consider are:

- 1) Paul was willing to suffer the loss of someone useful for the sake of others and brotherly love.
- 2) Philemon should be willing to forgive and move on in order to engender peace and brotherhood.

- 3) Onesimus was willing to humble himself and return to his master.
- 4) Paul was willing to suffer financial loss for the sake of a peaceful brotherly relationship between Onesimus and Philemon.

How often do we let former offenses, pride, and stubbornness stand in the way of healthy Christian relationships? Many of us need to "get over ourselves" and do what is best for others, Christ, and His kingdom! [Tim]
