The Power of Prayer by Jason T Carter

Prayer is one of the greatest blessings a child of God has, and Jesus promises in Matthew 7:7-8 that the Father will answer our prayers. However, Jesus shows that there is more than just asking involved in prayer. Brother Harold Fowler explains, "Ask is the simple prayer that indicates the dependence of the petitioner upon God, and his consciousness of his need....*Seek* suggests the personal effort of the one who prays to do his part toward getting his own prayers answered....*Knock* savors of perseverant importunity despite difficulties and hindrances, a vital factor in effective prayer."

This does not mean that God will answer every request in the fashion we think He should answer. Nor does it mean He will answer our prayers if we have impure motives. Jesus had previously taught on the proper motivation in prayer, warning against hypocrisy and vain repetitions (Matthew 6:5-7). He then gave a model for His disciples to use in making their

requests known (Matthew 6:8-13).

James also gives some guidance regarding prayer in his epistle. He writes that when we ask for wisdom, we must "ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways" (James 1:6-8).

James further teaches that we must be unselfish with our requests. "You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures" (James 4:3). It is not our pleasures, but God's will that we must seek. "Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him" (1 John 5:14-15). God is not a magic genie who will grant all of our desires; rather, He gives us what we need in order to accomplish His will.

SEPTEMBER PROGRESS REPORT, PART 2 McDonald Church of Christ, by Siphon Nkala

Dear Brethren,
 Greetings in the mighty name of our Lord Christ Jesus. I believe this report finds you well both physically and spiritually. We are right in our summer season and are experiencing hot temperatures; we anticipate for sufficient rainfall this season. The month of September was a very busy one, full of Church activities like gospel meetings and workshops.

On the 3rd of September, I accompanied V. Mlangeni to Bayethe Church of Christ at Esigodini where the ladies had their gospel meeting which had started on the 31st August. V. Mlangeni preached there and I was the interpreter. The subject was taken from 2Peter1:5ff, we were encouraged to add virtue to our Faith, as a result six (6) souls accepted the gospel and were baptized and added to the Church.

On the 10th and 17th of September I preached at MacDonal Church if Christ and as well taught bible lessons. The month of September was specifically for teaching about the CHURCH, how and where did it begin, taking the lesson from the PLAN, PROPHECY from the old testament and Jesus' PROMISE to build the Church and the entire fulfillment from Acts chapter 2. It is my hope and prayer that this fundamental subject may be well understood by members, especially the newly baptized. During the week on Wednesdays is when I organise men and the youth to participate on visiting. We visit the shut ins, backsliders and even non-Christians in their homes, teaching them.

On the 16th of September I attended a Preacher and Wives seminar which was held at City Center Church of Christ. It was a beneficial opportunity to give one another ideas on how to overcome tempers in our homes and specifically in the Church as leaders. I was

then elected Chairperson of the group.

On the 23rd as well I went to Kumbudzi Church of Christ in Mtshabezi area. Church leaders from different congregations within the community attended this workshop. My lesson was on how to preach at funerals. It was really interesting.

On Sunday the 24th, V. Mlangeni requested me to accompany him to Nashville Church of Christ in Gweru, where he was the main speaker. On our way back to Bulawayo, we had a very bad accident. A man who tried to cross the highway was almost hit by an oncoming vehicle and he quickly ran to ours and was knocked down to death. We greatly need your prayers for this predicament we came across. Thank you, brethren, for your unwavering support, not forgetting the financial support. May the God of peace be with you all.
