Time Flies

After my breakfast and morning coffee I rose from my chair to take my coffee cup to the kitchen sink. As I walked across the kitchen floor the quiet solitude was interrupted by loud cracking sounds emanating from every joint from my feet to my hips. I'm getting older, "this old body is decaying," I said to myself. Then I sat down to write a Happy Birthday note to my baby girl who today turned 17 years old (and not a baby any more).

The ancient Roman poet Publius Vergilius Maro (Virgil) once wrote, "Time flies never to be recalled." Time spent is time lost and oh how that time flies! In Job 9:25-26 we read, "Now my days are swifter than a runner; they flee away, they see no good. They pass by like swift ships, like an eagle swooping on its prey." This truth is a major theme throughout the Bible (1 Chronicles 29:15; Job 7:6-7, 14:1-2, 17:11; Psalm 39:5, 89:47, 90:5-7, 102:3; Proverbs 27:1; Ecclesiastes 6:12, 9:12; James 1:10; 1 Peter 1:24).

As I reflect on these I am reminded that this world is moving toward disorder, not order. Everything is decaying and wasting away. The Law of Entropy (second law of thermodynamics) says that nature tends to bring things to disorder. This is scientific truth that lies in opposition to evolutionary theory, but I digress. The fact is time here on earth is short and we are all headed to the grave and eternity. Indeed "the dust will return to the earth as it was, and the spirit will return to God who gave it" (Ecclesiastes 12:7). And "it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment" (Hebrews 9:27).

With that said let me suggest that there are only a few things that really matter:

Family: Last week we received news that my dad's youngest brother (my Uncle Melvin) has a brain tumor. It is very aggressive and without treatment may have as little as 90 days to live. I am glad I got to see him, sit next to him, and visit with him a few months ago when I was in Florida. I may never get that chance again and didn't realize then what a few short months would hold.

It has also been almost a year since my mother passed away after hip surgery that was intended to grant her a better quality of life here on earth. I am thankful that she was a faithful, godly Christian and her life has been made better in Christ. I hope to see her again some day.

Spend time with the ones you love and hold dear. Tell them what they mean to you and how much you love them. Spend time talking with them about God and His love, worship together, pray together, serve together, and make an eternal difference in their lives! I am so thankful for the godly Christians in my family that have preceded me into eternity and paved a path of Christ-like steps to walk in. I want to leave the same example for my children, grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

Fellowship: As I look at my friends and acquaintances, I am awed by the community of believers, those of like precious faith, with whom I am associated. In the Lord's Church I have an extended family, friends I can call on, brothers and sisters, fathers and mothers, who care for me and my family, physically and spiritually. I need to strengthen these bonds while I am here and protect my influence on those who look to me as an example of what a true believer is suppose to be.

But I also realize that I have an eternal relationship with God. Sin separated me from Him (Isaiah 59:1-2) but Christ through His blood reconciled me (Romans 5:10). I need to strengthen that relationship daily in prayer, study, worship, and service. When I consider His greatness helps me to humble myself and live to glorify His name (Psalm 8:1-4; Isaiah 40:22; 1 Peter 1:8). If I hope to have fellowship with Him in eternity I must develop it first here on earth!

Faithfulness: Nothing is more important! We are here on earth to glorify God in both body and spirit (1 Corinthians 6:20). Solomon concluded that man's entire purpose was to "fear God and keep His commandments (Ecclesiastes 12:13). That means we must be obedient to the saving gospel of Jesus Christ (Hebrews 5:8-9; 2 Thessalonians 1:7-8) and faithful unto death (Revelation 2:10). It should be the hope of every man to hear God say, "Well done, good and faithful servant" (Matthew 25:21-23). In order to do that I must repent of my sins (Acts 17:30), confess the sweet name of Jesus (Matthew 10:32-33), be baptized for the remission of sin (Acts 2:38) in order to be added to the body of Christ, the Church (Colossians 1:13). Have you done that? Are you faithful? "And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever" (1 John 2:17).

God does not force His will on anyone but gives man a free moral agency to choose whether or not he will love and serve God and where he will spend eternity. Robert Orben once said, "Time flies. It's up to you to be the navigator." You choose, you navigate, you decide how you will live these fleeting days on earth and where you will spend eternity. "I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. So choose life in order that you may live, you and your descendants" (Deuteronomy 30:19). Be faithful! **[Tim]**

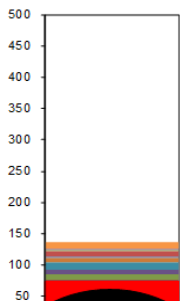

We arrived today from our Binga five day trip. We covered 1200 kms to and fro. The heat was unbearable but we managed to visit three congregations namely: Hwayibhetshu, Lubu and Msinampongo. We distributed food, clothing and WBS Courses in the local Tonga language. These Courses were sent to us by the Healing Hands International and we are very grateful indeed. At Hwayibhetshu, we taught the congregation its responsibility in choosing elders and deacons and also discussed Titus chapter 1 and ITimothy chapter 3. This congregation has God fearing men who can lead this congregation. At Lubu and Hwayibetshu, we showed them how to use the WBS Courses in converting the lost. We then rested on Monday at Mlibizi and tried fishing but only caught a small tiger fish and six small brims but it was good to rest and enjoy the beauty of the mighty Zambezi river. Lord willing, we plan to visit three other congregations during the first week of November.
