Calling for Backup by Tim Nichols

When the police are in trouble they call for backup. We admire them for their courage when they do their job properly, and we don't fault them for calling for backup when backup is needed.

David was involved in a situation that called for backup. So were Saul of Tarsus and the fornicator of Corinth. We admire them all the more because of their courage. David was a very good man in many ways. He cared deeply about the will of God and the faithfulness of God's people. He got sidetracked after seeing the beautiful Bathsheba. He moved forward into adultery, deception, and murder. We do not admire this dark series of events in his life. We see how far, quickly, and easily a good man can fall. We are saddened, ashamed, and warned by the knowledge of what this "man after God's own heart" was capable of performing. Yet, we admire David and count him as one of the greatest men who've ever walked the earth because, when the situation called for backup he backed up. We admire him all the more because of Psalm 51....

Saul of Tarsus charged ahead as a zealous Pharisee who had become so blind to the truth that he was a persecutor and murderer of Christians. After meeting Jesus on the Damascus Road and discovering that his position called for some backup he backed up. He ended up writing most of the New Testament scriptures. We have no admiration for his life of sin, but we admire him all the more for his humble turn away from it.

Most of us are appalled to think of the nature of the sin of the man in Corinth who had his father's wife. We cannot understand this one. It is so contrary to nature that we see it as evil and as revolting. Yet, when the Corinthian brethren loved him enough to withdraw from him, it appears that he was able to see the need for backup. The brethren were commanded to give him assurances of their continued brotherly affection for him after he had backed up.

A man who has sinned is not to be despised. In sinning he shows that he is about like other men. But the man who finds the courage to back up and correct himself after his public sin rises above other men. Although "all have sinned and come short of the glory of God", relatively few have found the strength to back up. His humility paradoxically places him in a higher category than proud men who cannot back up. We do not admire him for his sinless perfection, but no mortal possesses such perfection. We admire him for his honorable, righteous, upstanding, and courageous willingness to be governed by towering and godly principles instead of by weak and contemptible pride. We admire the character, the strength, and the integrity of the man who can back up when backup is called for. He stands tall with righteous David and with the morally impeccable apostle Paul.
