All Things Are Ready, Come to the Feast *by Tim Dooley*

Jesus replied to the chief priests and Pharisees in Matthew 22 with the Parable of the Wedding Feast. The people of Israel, especially the religious elite, had been bidden to the feast of God but had refused to come. They had killed the prophets sent before the Son and would soon also kill the Son. Since they would not come the invitation would be opened up to all who would come. However, there would be those who would come but would not have on a wedding garment. They would be cast out!

Coming to Jesus alone is not enough if we do not cleanse ourselves and put on a new garment. The blood of Jesus washes away our sins when we are baptized in Him (Acts 22:16) and that blood continues to cleanse us as long as we are faithful (1 John

1:7--10). But herein is the key, namely faithfulness. We must put off the old man (old garment) and put on the new man (wedding garment). "But you have not so learned Christ, if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness" (Ephesians 4:20-24).

Are you washed in the blood? Are you faithfully walking in the light? When the bridegroom comes will he find you clothed in white raiment (Revelation 3:5)? Be obedient, and be faithful! [Tim]

MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

Report from Nqobizitha and Jacob Moyo

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ hoping this report finds everyone well as we continue working in the Lord's vineyard. We are already in the last 2 months of the year time is flying, we would like to express our sincere gratitude for your support in all the Lord's work without you we would have not accomplished all this work and everything done for His glory. Matthew 5:16.

On the first week of the month, we conducted a 2 day Gospel Revival in Kumbudzi, about 100 km out of Bulawayo. We had great lessons there. The main theme of the revival was "Christ is our peace." It was very pleasant to see that we had a lot of youth in attendance. We wish to conduct a program to have a one day class with them, teaching them about the value of the Church.

The mortality rate still remains very high. On the

second week of the month we were helping at a funeral where one of our sisters in Christ lost a daughter. We helped with preaching and comforting the bereaved up to the last day on the burial. On the first day of the week, we broke the bread with our local Congregation.

We started the third week on another sad note as another sister lost a husband who was the bread winner. It is so humbling to see our brethren holding steadfast to the true Gospel even after all the painful situations, longing to finally get the crown that awaits those that endure till the end Revelations 2:10.

We continue sending Mealie meal to our needy brethren in rural areas. We sent 20 bags of Mealie meal to our rural brethren and also maize seeds as we realized most of our rural brethren do not have seeds to plant for the coming rain season. Most of

the fields were washed away and nothing was left the past farming season.

On the last week of the month, we visited the drip irrigation gardens. It is pleasing to see that the gardens are very productive with fresh kale, onions, tomatoes and carrots. Our rural brethren always send messages to say thank you very much for the farming method you introduced to them and continue to support. It has saved many lives physically and spiritually. The last first day of the week, we worshipped with our local Congregation, encouraging one another in hymns, in prayers and in scripture.

Thank you very much for all the support. We would have not accomplished all this without you, may the Lord continue to strengthen our bond in all the good works and everything done for His glory.
