## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

### NOVEMBER PROGRESS REPORT, PART 1 THE LORD'S WORK

We are happy to inform you that the Lord's work is progressing smoothly in Zimbabwe and we give all praise to the Lord.

### NEED FOR THE GOSPEL

When I grew up as a child in the rural areas of Southern Rhodesia then, in the mid 1950s, I used to enjoy watching aeroplanes glittering and passing by in the blue skies of Matabeleland Province. Guess what? When I returned from my medical check up trip in South Africa last week, I was privileged to be allocated a seat with two pilots in their cockpit, maybe because of overbooking. I watched these two pilots follow precisely their standing rules/procedures in flying their aircraft. They were very friendly to me and they actually showed me how they fly the aircraft and

what the three of us should do in case of an emergency. But all their instructions were just a rigmarole to me because they pushed so many buttons around and above them to get the aircraft started and taking off while simultaneously communicating with their Control Station. I wondered how they mastered all these procedures with so many check lists. Anyway, the most important thing which I enjoyed most during that hour and half flight from Johannesburg to Bulawayo was our conversation concerning the need for the Gospel to the whole world. The captain of this flight emphasized strongly when he said: "Mr Velaphi, the preaching of the Gospel Truth to the whole world hasn't been greater than now." He added that : "many people nowadays do not see the need to worship God. In Europe for example, many worship soccer and others their possessions. This is why our world is so chaotic,

individualism and extremism are all rife, violence, hatred and senseless killings are all over the globe. As long as the world fails to embrace the Gospel, such chaos will always be greater. World leaders will always meet to solve these problems but solutions will always elude them as long as Christ is out of their equation." Muu! it dawned in my mind that as Christians, wherever we are, we must double our efforts of reaching out to the whole world with the Gospel because the world is still in spiritual darkness. This is the reason why we always thank you our loving brothers and sisters in Canada and the United States for your unflinching support for the Lord's work in Zimbabwe. Without this great support, what could we do in winning the lost for Christ? May God get all the glory for inspiring you to do so much for Him in this country. VELAPHI
