Many times when we go to our Heavenly Father in prayer, it would be like as if we would be talking to ourselves and God would not be listening. But the truth is that God would be listening to every word we utter and He answers our prayers timeously.

Zimbabwe is a very good example. True, in Zimbabwe, we have and are still spreading the Good News unhindered but economically our country was going downstream. At the right time, God heard our cries and changed the previous government very peacefully.
