### NOVEMBER PROGRESS REPORT, PART 2 BAPTISM

We are happy to inform you that during the month in review, seven souls obeyed the Gospel of Christ and were baptized. We give all praise to our Lord!

### NTABAZINDUNA

We had an unfortunate incident whereby a very strong wind destroyed the roof of the church building at Ntabazinduna. This brought so much sadness to the Christians there. We are happy to report that through the funds donated by our brothers and sisters at Rainbow, the roof has been repaired and Christians there are smiling again. They were very grateful indeed to the Elders at Rainbow.

### PREACHING & FOOD DISTRIBUTION

We continued preaching and distributed food to the needy Christians at Binga, Stanhope, Chesa, McDonald and Ntabazinduna. All Christians in these areas are sending their "thankfulness" to you our beloved in the Lord.

### LOSS

We lost of our two sisters in the Lord who were very faithful indeed. They suffered from cancer and diabetes. May our good Lord comfort their families! When we preach at such occasions, we always remind mourners that our Lord promised us a better home than this where we shall never grow old or die. (Revelation 21:3-4; John 14:2-3).

### ECONOMY

We have an economy that is still increasingly fragile and life is now very difficult for the general populace in Zimbabwe. The price of basic commodities has sky-rocketed and bread now costs US\$1.45 from between 90cents and a dollar. The shortage of fuel has once again bounced back and all garages are now characterized by long queues of cars for the precious commodity. This fuel shortage will hit farmers below the belt because they were just beginning to prepare planting their early crops as the summer season kicks off. We pray and trust that these austerity measures adopted by the government will yield good fruits beneficial to the whole economy.
