ASK FOR THE OLD PATHS *by Jason T Carter*

In the entertainment industry, nostalgia is big business. The *Star Wars* franchise began in 1977, was resurrected in the late '90s and again just a few years ago to huge profits. Netflix just announced this past week that it was developing a new *She-Ra* cartoon, originally a popular series in the 1980s. Big-screen adaptations of *Transformers*, *G.I. Joe*, and the like attract adults who were fans when they were much younger. The same is true in the music industry, with bands begging for fans to spend money on reunion tours and greatest hits albums.

Spiritually, there is value in pursuing the pure, original doctrine of God. This was true under the old covenant, and it is still true today in this Christian age. The weeping prophet relayed this message from Jehovah to the people: "Stand in the ways and see, and ask for the old paths, where the good way is, and walk in it; then you will find rest for your souls" (Jeremiah 6:16).

This principle holds true today. Following the example of first century Christians, we should "continued steadfastly in the

apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers" (Acts 2:42). The only way to do that is to know the apostles' doctrine, to study the Word and walk in it.

God can make us complete through His Word: "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work" (2 Timothy 3:16-17). Again, the only way this can happen is to make an effort to know the Scriptures; God will not force it upon us.

The importance of knowing God's untarnished Word is also shown when we connect Romans 10:17 and Hebrews 11:6. Without a diligent, seeking faith—which is developed by hearing the Word—it is impossible to please God.

Whatever new doctrine comes along, as Christians we must stand firm in the old ways of the apostles who were inspired by God. When someone tries to lead you astray, "ask for the old paths."

NOVEMBER 2017 REPORT, PART 2

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

Mnondou School

I was invited to go and speak at the graduation ceremony of kindergarten kids at Mnondou Primary School in Nyamandlovu in Matebeleland Norrh.

This ceremony was attended by parents, villagers and officials from the ministry of education. My topic was the importance of Early Child Development. After urging parents to send their children to school for Early Development Programs for their children, I also urged parents to teach their children about the Bible while they were still young so that they may develop a strong moral fibre. If we catch them while they are young, we will not lose them when they are old. Prov 22:6 "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not depart from it." I also donated a box full of pencils

to the school which came from brother Dorian Flynn and his evangelism team in the United States. The headmaster Mrs Ngwenya was very grateful indeed together with teaching staff.

Evangelism

We did not do much evangelism work in November as we continued to monitor the political situation in the country. In previous elections, we would witness untold political violence but this time around the change of government was peaceful because almost everyone was fed up with the previous government administration thus peace prevailed as no one opposed the changes which took place. Lord willing, we shall resume our evangelism activities this month. However, we visited some few rural areas and helped Christians bury their dead. We also had an elders’ meeting at Khumalo. The meeting was aimed at sharpening our leadership skills and remind ourselves to always stick to the Bible in all

challenges we face as elders. We also had a preachers and their wives meeting which looked at ways of helping Christians grow spiritually. Stella and I also took a short break to South Africa for medical check up. The medical reports were good but the doctor urged us to take some rest now and then considering our age and also desist from eating sugary things and exercise regularly.
