## MISSIONARY UPDATE: VELAPHI MELANGANI

### NOVEMBER 2017 REPORT, PART 3

Report from : Dumisani Mafu who preaches at EN-yandeni

#### Introduction

We greet you in the Name of our King Jesus Chris. May his tender mercies always keep you under his wings of love and care.

1. Work: The work of the Lord's Church this month focused on visitations, invitations and teaching followup.

1.1 Teaching: We visited Mrs. Ncube of Village 6. She was once a member of the Lord's Churches but was attending a sect. We visited her on two different occasions but she had failed to respond positively. Lessons taught were entitled, "Staying faithful to the Lord has greater value" (Heb 11:6), "Can God receive me back again?" (Is 1:17-18)

1:2 Visitations: We made some visitations targeting certain individuals. Out of ten, four were able to attend fellowship service. The four women were Mrs. Mpofu, Mrs. Dube, Mrs. Moyo and Mrs. Ncube. Mrs. Ncube responded positively as she had backslidden few years down the line. The congregation accepted her back with joy. Other individuals accepted us to come and present lessons to them.

2. Sunday Service On the Lord's day we come for worship, prayers, and partaking at the Lord's table both wine and bread. Lessons and Preaching are also done this day. Some topics given were "Staying prayerful and praising God amidst challenges" (Psa 57:1-11) and "The blessedness of a life filled with confession of our sins." (Psa 32:1-5) The theme of our Fellowship Sunday was "Recovering our first love" (Rev 2:1--5) and a lesson entitled

"Backsliding" was presented (Jer 8:4).

3 Attendance: 12 adults, 9 children. Giving \$4.80

4 Obituary: As a congregation, we attended a funeral wake and a burial service. Nkosi Ndlovu, a boy who was a student at Nyandeni Primary School, was involved in a fatal accident when donkeys which were strapped to the scotchcart were disturbed and suddenly tipped the scotchcart over, pinning the boy underneath. He died on 25-11-17 and was laid to rest on 28: 11-17

5. Challenges: The Lord's work goes on in such hard times. Our gratitude to you is the love you continually show us at all times by supporting us financially and praying for us and you still continue to do. May you continue this gracious hand in His service. We thank you.
